Jizobana Observatory – Mitahama Beach

First take in a view of the islets from the slightly elevated Jizobana Observatory. Enjoy the sounds of the water as it ebbs and flows, as you travel along this single road filled with a variety of views. Continue walking until you reach the calm sandy beach, that opens out into the sea before your eyes.

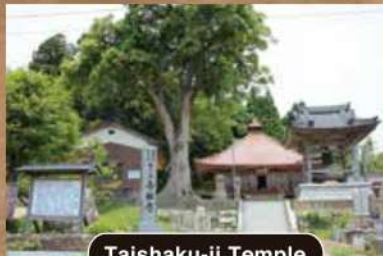

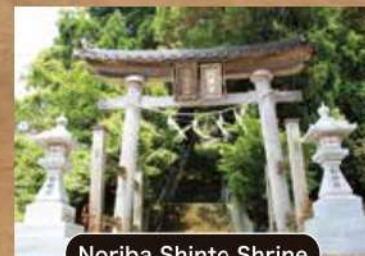

Temples and shrines located in the village. Experience old-fashioned Japan, reminiscent in the orderly and clean gardens, stone steps, and more.

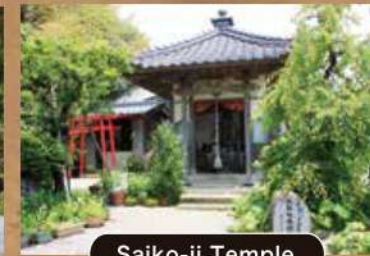
There are many small alleys in Shimonohama, along them, are shrines and temples that blend effortlessly into the town, easy to drop into when passing by.

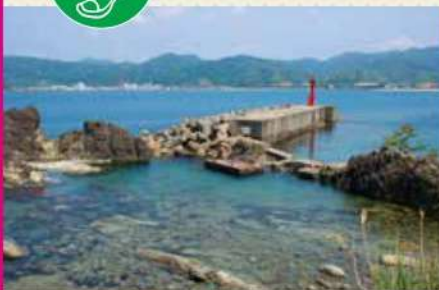

Jizobana Observatory – Mitahama Beach



If you continue through the narrow streets lined with inns to the north, you will come across the road to Mitahama Beach. In the beach area, there are volcanic rocks that are geometrically shaped with fissures. They have been formed by lava flow that cooled and solidified over a wide area when there was volcanic activity here in ancient times. The main attraction for visitors to this area is to visualize ancient times while gazing at the many rare and strangely shaped rocks. Although Kasumi Bay is quite large, this area is one of its highlights on its western side.
