Circling Shibayama Bay

Recommended route:
Nyu Shinto Shrine (near the station) → Go north with views of Shibayama Bay on one side → Shibayama Port where large boats dock → Okinoura Fishing Port where small fishing boats gather → Red lighthouse where you can also fish. Enjoy the serene fishing port landscape.

Take JR to Amarube Bridge

Accommodation is close to JR Shibayama Station, so use the free pass to go to Amarube Station, which is 3 stations away. Enjoy the beauty and thrill of the sea as you cross the Amarube Railroad Bridge on the journey.

JR Shibayama Station: A modern box-shaped
unstaffed station

Nyu Shinto Shrine: Easy to stop by this shrine located on the roadside.
Enjoy the splendid torii gate, and a well-maintained grounds.

Shibayama Bay / Shibayama Port: A good port with a natural deep cove peculiar to the rias coast.
Large fishing boats line up on the highly transparent water surface, and seagulls play.

Red Lighthouse



Okinoura Fishing Port: A quiet fishing port located to the far end of the large Shibayama Bay.
Many small boats dock here.

Red Lighthouse: Visitors who take the road along the fishing port of Okinoura will find the red lighthouse at the end of a straight jetty. Here, you can enjoy fishing while gazing out over the expansive Sea of Japan. Return journey starts here.
